We are now looking for a National Coach who, through a qualified and continuous effort, will help elevate the development of Denmark's best female players to an even higher level.

A Focus on "Learning to Learn" and Long-term Development

As a National Coach at DGU, you will join a team that values professionalism, passion, and patience. We operate based on the core principle of **"learning to learn"** - empowering players with the skills, self-awareness, and tools necessary to take full ownership of their own careers and development plans.

We believe in long-term development, equipping players to perform at the highest international level while building successful careers and meaningful lives.

You will work closely with four other National Coaches, our specialists in physical and mental training, and the rest of the elite department staff.

Value-driven collaboration is our focus: We prioritize a strong partnership with the player's entire team - including home clubs, personal coaches, parents, caddies and other stakeholders- to ensure optimal development and alignment.

A Holistic Approach to the Player's Life

We are looking for a coach who masters a holistic approach, where technical skills are integrated with physical strength, mental resilience, and tactical intelligence. The role balances strategic planning with active execution:

- **Integrated Coaching & Sparring:** You will lead weekly training sessions, focusing on technical swing changes, short game, and



putting. You ensure that technical adjustments always align with the player's physical capabilities and mental readiness.

- **Planning & Ownership:** You help set the strategic direction for player development and are responsible for organizing training camps and tournament preparation.
- **Statistics & Analysis:** You possess a deep understanding of elite-level data tools. You use data as a pedagogical tool to strengthen the player's own understanding of their game.

International Scope & Stakeholders

As several of our professional players and college students are based in the USA, and all players follow international tournament schedules, significant travel is required. Expect approximately 4 weeks of training camps, 4 weekend sessions, and a minimum of 8-10 tournament weeks annually.

- A passion for working with "the whole person" and not just the

athlete.

- Structured in planning, yet driven by the close, daily collaboration on the range and the course.
- Ability to navigate a role that shifts between being the primary coach and being part of a larger support team.
